
**A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF NIPAWIN, IN THE PROVINCE OF
SASKATCHEWAN TO PROVIDE FOR DISCOUNTS AND PENALTIES ON
CURRENT TAXES PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 272 OF THE
MUNICIPALITIES ACT**

The Council of the Town of Nipawin, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. Current taxes shall be considered due on the thirty-first (31st) day of July in each year.
2. To encourage prompt payment of current taxes, the following discount shall be allowed:
 - On eligible payments received during the month of January – a discount rate of Diamond North Credit Union prime rate as of December 31st of the previous year less 0.5%
 - On eligible payments received during the month of February – a discount rate of Diamond North Credit Union prime rate as of December 31st of the previous year less 1.0%
 - On eligible payments received during the month of March – a discount rate of Diamond North Credit Union prime rate as of December 31st of the previous year less 1.5%
3. Each year an amount shall be added to all current taxes outstanding during the months of August to December inclusive in the following manner:
 - On August 1st - 1% on unpaid balance
 - On September 1st - 1% on unpaid balance
 - On October 1st - 1% on unpaid balance
 - On November 1st - 1% on unpaid balance
 - On December 1st - 1% on unpaid balance
4. Where payments are received prior to the completion of the Tax Roll, the same shall be estimated on the basis of the taxes levied against the property for the preceding year or based on prepayment notices which may be mailed in January each year.
5. The discounts authorized under the provisions of Section 2 of this Bylaw shall only apply to municipal mill rate tax and municipal base tax.
6. Bylaw No. 885/08 is hereby repealed; provided however, that the repeal of the said Bylaw shall not affect any right or rights accrued or accruing thereunder at the time of coming into force of this Bylaw.

7. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the 1st day of January, 2019.
