**A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF NIPAWIN, IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO  
AUTHORIZE AN AMENDMENT TO BYLAW 1024/17 – A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE  
PROCEEDINGS OF MUNICIPAL COUNCIL AND COMMITTEES OF COUNCIL**

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The Council of the Town of Nipawin in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

THAT Section 18.1 and Section 27.1(e) of Bylaw 1024/17 be amended as indicated in **bold** below:

9. Reports of Standing & Special Committees;
10. Reports of Boards & Committees;
11. Communications;
12. Petitions;

- 13. 14. New Business;**
- 14. 17. Introduction & Consideration of Bylaws;**
15. Round Table;
16. Public forum;
- ~~17. Introduction & Consideration of Bylaws;~~
- 17. 18. In-Camera Committee of the Whole; and**
- 18. 19. Adjournment.**

THAT Section 27.1(e) be amended as indicated in **bold** below:

**27. Conduct of Public & Delegations**

27.1 All persons in the public gallery at a Council meeting shall:

- (e) refrain from making ~~audio or~~ video recordings of Council proceedings.  
**Audio recordings are permitted;**
