

BYLAW NO. 705/97

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF NIPAWIN TO REGULATE THE TIME A CHILD SHALL BE IN A PUBLIC PLACE

The Council of the Town of Nipawin, in the Province of Saskatchewan, as authorized by the Urban Municipality Act, 1984, enacts as follows:

PART 1 - INTRODUCTION

1. **TITLE:**

This bylaw shall be known and may be cited as the CURFEW BYLAW.

2. **PURPOSE:**

The purpose of this bylaw is to regulate the time at which a child is allowed to be in a public place without direct guardianship.

PART 2 - INTERPRETATION

3. **CHILD** - means a person who is under the age of 15 years.

4. **GUARDIAN** - means a person who is 18 years of age or older.

5. **PUBLIC PLACE** - includes any place to which the public have access as of right or by invitation, express or implied.

PART 3 - REGULATIONS

6. No child under the age of 15 years shall be in a public place in the Town of Nipawin between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. unless under the direct supervision of a parent or guardian.

7. A child under the age of 15 years found in a public place between 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m., may be taken by a Peace Officer to the child's home and turned over to a parent, a guardian or a responsible adult or may be delivered to an "officer" as defined under The Child and Family Services Act, S.S. c C-7.2.

PART 4 - PENALTIES

8. Any person under the age of 15 years who contravenes this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties provided in this Section.

(1) Any parent, guardian, or person responsible for the custody of a child under the age of 15 years whose child or ward contravenes this bylaw is guilty of an offence and is liable to the penalties as specified in the General Penalty Bylaw of the Town of Nipawin.

(2) Any person contravening this bylaw is liable to the following penalties:

- a) For the first offence, to a fine of a minimum of \$50.00 and a maximum of \$200.00;
- b) For each subsequent offence, to a fine of a minimum of \$100.00 and a maximum of \$500.00;

9. Upon being served with a Summary Offence Ticket, a violator of this bylaw may by mail pay the specified penalty sum by the date specified, or follow options as outlined on the reverse side of the Summary Offence Ticket.

10. The Summary Offence Ticket Information shall be in Form "1" Appendix "A" attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw.

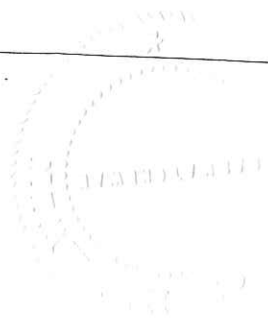
