The Town **Property Maintenance & Nuisance Abatement Bylaw** is this month's featured bylaw. It is a Bylaw of the Town of Nipawin that speaks to the accepted community standard for the cleanliness and upkeep of properties and buildings and includes:

- Grass or lawn vegetation in excess of 15 cm (6")
- Disposal of garbage and refuse (including vegetation trimming/cuttings)
- Maintenance of buildings and accessory buildings, including the residence
- Junked vehicles or machinery (if the vehicle would not be permitted to operate on the roadway, it would be considered a junk vehicle and would need to be kept indoors); and
- Fences

## REMINDERS:

- If you have not already done so, please remember to licence your cat(s) and / or dog(s). Having your pet licensed helps to ensure that, should your pet accidentally get loose, animal ownership can quickly be established and your pet returned home. The cost of licensing is \$18 per year for neutered or spayed pets.
- Please keep a safe distance from town equipment such as the street sweeper as town crews continue to clean the streets of winter debris.
- Line painting and crack sealing is scheduled to begin in June. Thank you for your continued patience and for keeping a safe distance from crews working on our streets.
- Over the difficult winter the Town experienced several water main breaks this spring. Resurfacing of the pavement and curb replacements will occur later this summer.
- Please do NOT overfill recycle and waste carts and ensure the lid of the cart can be closed. Also, please remove your garbage/recycling carts from roadways as soon as possible after pick up. This ensures that crews can clean the roadways as quickly as possible.
