



## **UPDATE REPORT from Mayor David Trann (September 2016)**

### **Main Street Saskatchewan Program**

Nipawin has advanced to Main Street Saskatchewan's Accredited level by the Government of Saskatchewan. The program aims to help revitalize historic commercial downtowns by supporting local downtown development, heritage conservation and economic growth. To reach this level, we are making a commitment to the Provincial Government towards meeting the highest performance standards in order to receive the full benefit of training and technical support including matching grant funding. Further information on the program will be coming from the Nipawin Business Improvement District (BID). I would like to thank the volunteer BID Board of the Directors and their staff for their hard work and dedication towards achieving this status. Deputy Mayor Michael Botterill spoke on my behalf at the Saskatchewan Legislature in Regina.

### **Curbside Compost Program and Spring and Fall Back Lane Garbage Pick Up Program**

Residents are reminded that the weekly curbside compost program will continue until, Wednesday, October 26<sup>th</sup>. There will be no gate fees charged at the landfill for clean wood, tree trimmings and compost material. Please ensure that your material is separated and not mixed in with household waste. Otherwise gate fees are applied.

The Town of Nipawin, along with our neighbouring municipal partners are in the process of forming the North East Regional Waste Management Authority. With the formation of the Authority, the Town will no longer be the sole managing partner of the landfill and as such are unable to continue the annual spring and fall back lane clean-up program of those items not normally picked up during regular weekly garbage and recycle collection.

### **Water Treatment Plant**

In my last month message, I had mentioned the significance of the \$13.6 million in funding that Nipawin received for the construction of the new water treatment plant. The investment made by the Province and Federal Governments has allowed a decrease in your monthly infrastructure charge.
