



# MUNICIPAL ORDER

## FIRE BAN

### WHEREAS

In the opinion of the Town of Nipawin an extreme fire hazard condition exists within the municipality;

### THEREFORE

- i) No person shall light, or start, or allow or cause to be lighted, ignited, or started a fire of any kind, whatsoever in the open air. This includes fire pits, chimineas or any wood or solid fuel burning appliance.
- ii) The lighting or discharge of fireworks is strictly prohibited.
- iii) The use of propane or natural gas fuelled BBQs and appliances is permitted.

**This fire ban includes and applies to all lands located within the Town of Nipawin**

***This order takes effect May 17th, 2023 and will continue to be in effect until further notification from the municipality***
