REPORT TO: Supervisor of Parks and Facilities

SUBORDINATE POSITIONS: N/A

PURPOSE OF POSITION: Responsible for assisting with ongoing maintenance and

repair of municipal parks and properties.

SCOPE

(The way that the position contributes to and impacts on the municipality)

Reporting to the Manager of Parks and Recreation under the direct supervision of the Parks and Facilities Supervisor, the Seasonal Labourer will perform general labour duties as assigned by the Parks and Recreation Foreperson.

QUALIFICATIONS

(Minimum requirements/preferred requirements of the position to be effective and efficient)

- 1. Must have valid class 5 Driver's license
- 2. High school diploma or equivalent, preferred
- 3. Must provide personal CSA approved safety boots/footwear

RESPONSIBILITIES

(Major responsibilities and target accomplishments expected of the position)

- 1. Assist in general maintenance of municipal parks, cemeteries and facilities
- 2. Street and road maintenance, spring clean-up, etc.
- 3. Turf Maintenance (grass cutting, fertilizing, etc.)
- 4. Conduct routine clean-up and garbage removal from all cemeteries, parks and facilities
- 5. Pruning shrubs and trimming trees.
- 6. Other general labour duties as assigned.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES

(The knowledge, skills and attitudes required for satisfactory job performance)

Knowledge

The Seasonal Labourer must have working knowledge in the following areas:

- 1. Operation of maintenance equipment such as lawn mowers, grass trimmers, etc. is an asset
- 2. General maintenance or construction knowledge an asset
- 3. Ability to maneuver trucks, trailers and equipment safely and efficiently
- 4. Knowledge of landscaping tools, equipment, and lawn maintenance equipment an asset
- 5. Knowledge of the Municipal Environments



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Skills

The Seasonal Labourer must demonstrate the following skills:

- 1. Following directions and initiatives set forth by the immediate supervisor
- 2. Following and carrying out direction without immediate supervision
- 3. Maintain strict confidentiality
- 4. Ability to cope with multiple requests and subjects simultaneously
- 5. Attention to detail and productive use of time
- 6. Physically capable of performing assigned duties

Personal Attributes

The Seasonal Labourer must demonstrate the following personal attributes:

- 1. Strong Communication and ability to adapt
- 2. Respectful and have professional courteous demeanour
- 3. Ability to work in a dedicated team 1st environment
- 4. Punctual and dedicated

WORKING CONDITIONS

(The nature of physical effort, environmental conditions, sensory and mental demands and typical hours of work)

- **1.** May be subject to inclement weather and/or weather extremes during the discharge of responsibilities.
- 2. Considerable periods of standing and/or moderate walking may be required
- 3. Tasks are somewhat diverse, and some interpretation is required
- **4.** Typical activities include lifting, reaching, sitting in vehicles, standing, walking, considerable visual attention to details
