



Town of Nipawin Information Release – COVID-19 Pandemic

The Town of Nipawin has been closely monitoring the COVID-19 pandemic in Saskatchewan. The health, safety, and well-being of our employees and members of the public, and maintaining essential services are our top priorities.

The Town of Nipawin will be taking the following steps at this time to reduce the risk of transmission to employees and members of the public:

Recreational Facilities

- Centennial Arena, Jubilee Arena, East Pleasantview Rink, and Pinedale Rink will be closed to the public until further notice
- Nipawin Evergreen Centre office, curling rink, auditorium, and meeting rooms will be closed to the public. All programs at the facility will be cancelled until further notice. The Spot Restaurant will remain open at this time.
- Cross-country ski equipment and crokicurl equipment will not be available for use at this time.

Visitor Center

- The Visitor Centre & Tourism Office will be closed to the public until further notice.

Town Office

- The Town Office will be closed to the public until further notice.
- Payments for property taxes, utility bills, and accounts receivable can still be made through online banking. Charges for late payments will be waived until further notice.
- Water turn-ons and turn-offs can be scheduled by calling the Town Office at 306-862-9866 during our regular business hours (Monday to Friday, 8:30 am – 12:00 pm and 1:00 pm – 4:30 pm)
