**BYLAW UPDATES**

*Nipawin, Saskatchewan – March 12, 2020*

The Town of Nipawin wishes to inform the community that effective Monday, March 9, 2020 Council has passed a new, updated **Traffic Bylaw**.

Key highlights:

- The new Traffic Bylaw now includes snowmobile and ATV operations;
- Taxi regulations are now contained in the new Traffic Bylaw;
- Owners of recreational vehicles including cabin trailers, motor homes, boat trailers, etc. are not permitted to park these vehicles on Town streets for more than 48-hours unless a permit has been obtained from the Town Office. This will allow for short-term parking of these vehicles, while at the same time ensuring streets are not being blocked for long periods of time;
- Vehicles are not allowed to be parked on a street for longer than 48-hours;
- Unregistered vehicles may not be parked on public streets at any time.

The Town has also recently passed an updated **Property Maintenance and Nuisance Abatement Bylaw** which establishes standards for the maintenance and occupancy of property to ensure that such standards be maintained for items including things that affect:

- The safety, health, or welfare of people in the neighbourhood;
- People's use and enjoyment of their property; or
- The amenity of a neighbourhood.
