### ACCEPTED MATERIALS

#### *All containers must be labelled*

**ADHESIVES** – contact cement, resin, glue, sealer, caulking

**AEROSOLS** – hair spray, insect repellent, furniture cleaner, paint, automotive aerosols, air dusters, flat fixer

**AUTOMOTIVE** – used oil, oil filters, antifreeze, carburetor cleaner, batteries, fuel, windshield washer, transmission fluid, brake fluid, empty oil containers and pails

**BATTERIES** – automotive, alkali, NiCad, lithium, NiMH

**CLEANERS** – floor, carpet, clothing, oven, glass, waxes, disinfectant, deodorant, metal polish

**CYLINDERS** – propane, helium, oxygen, acetylene, fire extinguishers

**CORROSIVES** – drain cleaner, degreaser, ammonia, battery acid, oven cleaner, acids and bases

**FUELS** – gasoline, diesel, kerosene, oil/gas mixture

**LIGHT BULBS & BALLASTS** – fluorescent light ballasts (with or without PCBs), CFL bulbs and tubes

**MERCURY** – mercury, thermometers, thermostats

**OXIDIZING CHEMICALS** – chlorine, bleach, pool chemicals, fertilizer, hydrogen peroxide

**PAINT RELATED PRODUCTS\*** – paint, stain, wood preservative, roofing tar, driveway tar

**PESTICIDES** – home and garden pesticides, herbicides, insecticides, rodent killer

**PHARMACEUTICALS & MAKE-UP** – prescription and over-the-counter medicines

**SOLVENTS** – Varsol, paint thinner, acetone, toluene, xylene, alcohol, benzene, nail polish remover, glue remover

**OTHER MATERIALS** – asbestos (must be triple contained), photographic chemicals, pigments, dyes, hair colour, lead, mothballs, pet supplies, septic tank chemicals

### PROHIBITED MATERIALS

**AGRICULTURAL, COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL HAZARDOUS WASTE AND CONTAINERS\*\***

**AMMUNITION**

**BIOLOGICAL OR INFECTIOUS WASTE**

**APPLIANCES**

**COMPRESSED GASES** – other than propane, helium, oxygen and acetylene cylinders, fire extinguishers and aerosols

**ELECTRONICS**

**EXPLOSIVES**

**SHARPS** – needles

**SMOKE DETECTORS**

**UNKNOWN MATERIALS**

**USED TIRES** – automotive and bicycle tires

**WEAPONS**

## Other Recycling Opportunities in the Community

A variety of local retailers accept specific materials for disposal or recycling during their regular business hours. Visit <http://saskwastereduction.ca/> for a list of places that accept household hazardous waste material.

### Paint

Leftover paint and empty paint cans are accepted without charge at all SARCAN recycling depots in Saskatoon. A complete list of items accepted under the Saskatchewan Paint Recycling Program can be found on SARCAN's website. Paint that is not accepted through the SARCAN program can be dropped off at Household Hazardous Waste events.

### Electronics

Electronics are accepted without charge at a number of drop-off centres throughout Saskatchewan, including all SARCAN recycling depots. Approved products include:

- Desktop and portable computers
- Computer equipment (keyboards, mice, cables and internal components)
- Desktop printers and fax machines, displays (TV's, computer monitors)
- Audio / video systems (personal or portable, vehicle, home)
- Non-cellular telephones
