Monthly Update

Nipawin RCMP responded to 256 calls for service in the month of August , 2017, which was an increase from the 225 reported in August of 2016.

- On August 10th, 2017, local RCMP members led the Premier's Cup boat parade kicking off the 30th annual Premier's Cup.
- Of the 22 calls for service relating to mischief, 15 of them pertained to someone interfering with the lawful enjoyment of an individual's property, 1 of the 22 calls involved vehicle damage, 4 calls related to damage at local businesses, 1 was in relation to vandalism to the washrooms at the Exhibition Grounds and 1 call pertained to Public Mischief which is causing a police officer to act on information knowing that the information is false.
- Of the 6 Break and Enter files reported in the month of August, 2 related to residential homes in which there was not anything taken, 2 more related to residential homes in which one had food stolen and the other had a stereo taken, 1 break and enter pertained to a local business and the other was associated to a shed .
- Over the last several months Nipawin RCMP members have been working diligently to gather intelligence on the local drug trade and those individuals involved. As a result of these efforts the Prince Albert Combined Forces Special Enforcement Unit attended and worked with local members in late June and July. As a result of this combined effort three individuals were arrested and charged with the following offences: 15 year old female charged with 1 count of Trafficking Cocaine and 1 count of Possession of Property Obtained by Crime; 26 year old male charged with 4 counts of Trafficking Cocaine, 1 count of Possession of Cocaine and 3 counts of Possession of Property Obtained by Crime; 31 year old male charged with 1 count of Trafficking Cocaine and 1 count of Possession of Property Obtained by Crime. All these matters are still before the courts.
- Nipawin Detachment does not have 24 hour policing. There are periods when members are on call and readily available to respond should they be called out. Hours of work are constantly assessed and human resources are utilized to try and cover peak periods.
- Nipawin Detachment is currently running at full establishment.
