As well as many nominations.



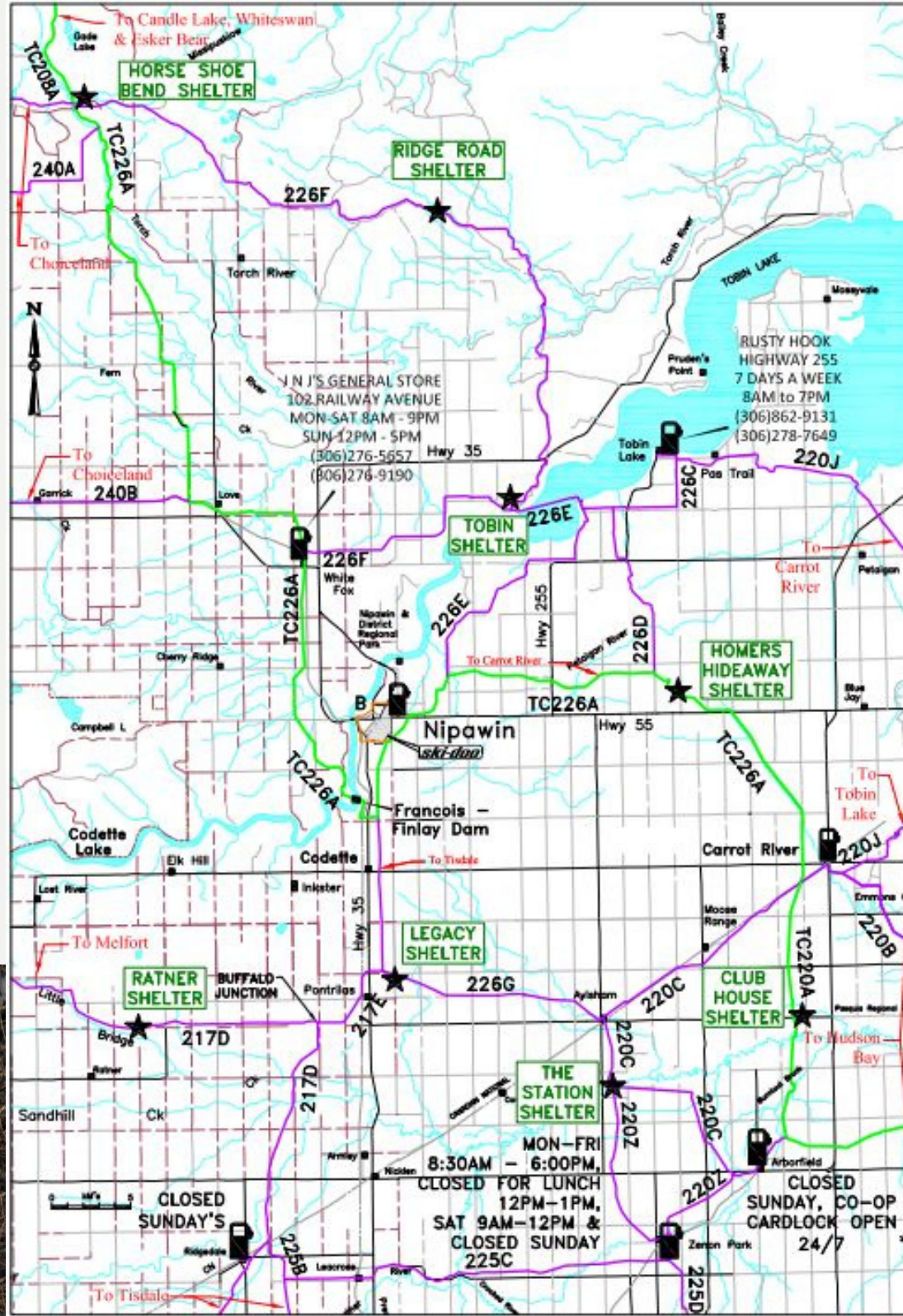

The Twin Lakes Trail Blazers Snowmobile Club was formed in 1979 and is an active member of the Saskatchewan Snowmobile Association, Saskatchewan Tourism and the Nipawin Chamber of Commerce.

The Club owns a clubhouse to hold monthly meetings and a 24 x 40 heated shop to maintain and store the grooming equipment and club sleds. The Club employs one groomer operator and consists of approximately 100 member volunteers.
