DOG PARK INITIATIVE

Nipawin, Saskatchewan – September 6, 2019

The Town of Nipawin wishes to confirm that a proposal to set aside land for a potential dog park was presented to Council's Operations Standing Committee at their meeting of August 19th. The proposal recommended by staff was not accepted by the Committee for recommendation to Council as the Committee members requested considerable additional information from staff before deliberating further. In part, staff was requested to ensure affected stakeholders are contacted in advance for their comments. This information collection is currently underway.

It is important to confirm that the development of a dog park is not an identified priority within the Town of Nipawin Council's current Strategic Plan. Therefore, this matter will be included as a topic of discussion when Council and staff meet at the end of October for their annual review and update of the Strategic Plan, specifically during the discussions regarding the development of a Community Parks Plan. As always, all approved initiatives from the Strategic Planning meetings are subject to further review during the annual budget deliberations. The revised Strategic Plan is made available to the public after adoption by Council (placed on the Town of Nipawin website, Facebook page, and presented to the public at the annual Town of Nipawin Open House).
