## **Purpose**

The purpose of this policy is to set guidelines for municipal elections.

### 1. Election Dates

Election dates are determined by the Provincial Government and shall be held every fourth year on the  $2^{nd}$  Wednesday of November.

### 2. Election Officials Remuneration Rates

**Returning Officer** 

- Chief Administrative Officer

# a. Polling Stations (Election day)

Deputy Returning Officer - \$250.00

Poll Clerks

- \$200.00

Contable

- \$165.00

## b. Advance & Special Polls

Deputy Returning Officer - Town staff

\$100.00 (if town staff not available)

Poll Clerk

- Town staff

\$ 85.00 (if Town staff not available)

Election Officials are required to attend a mandatory training session prior to the election and will be paid \$25.00 remuneration for attending.

## 3. Mail-In Voting

Mail in Voting will be allowed as per bylaw.

Voters must register in person with the Town Office no later than 10 days prior to the election.

#### 4. Voter's List

Voters' List not required as per bylaw.
