Drinking Water Advisory for 200 Timber Drive Lake Country CO-OP

Monday, May 6, the Town of Nipawin shut off a water main feeding CO-OP on Timber Drive so they could replace a valve in their building.

Due to the nature of the work, the water distribution to their building cannot be ensured to be always safe and therefore a **Drinking Water Advisory** will be issued for 200 Timber Drive.

A Drinking Water Advisory means:

- **Boil all water used for drinking purposes for at least one 1-minute (rolling boil) prior to use**
- **Boil water that will be used for other activities where it may be ingested, including:**
 - **Brushing teeth or soaking false teeth**
 - **Dishwashing, unless sanitized in another fashion**
 - **Washing fruits and vegetables**
 - **Hot or cold beverages**
 - **Ice cubes**
- **Ensure that younger children and infants are sponge bathed**
- **Typically, you do not need to boil water for other household purposes. Adults, adolescents and older children may shower, bath and wash using tap water, but should avoid swallowing water.**
- **Laundry should not be affected**

Once the water has been evaluated and is deemed safe for human consumption, a notice will be issued to lift the advisory.
