Semi-Skilled Labourer – Curling Ice Technician / Events & Facility Maintenance - Nipawin Evergreen Centre

The Town of Nipawin is seeking a motivated, reliable, and self-directed individual to join the Leisure Services Department as a Full-Time Semi-Skilled Labourer at the Nipawin Evergreen Centre.

This is a multi-functional position responsible for curling ice maintenance, event setup and teardown, and facility maintenance. The successful candidate must be able to work independently and support a wide range of operations within Leisure Services.

Key Responsibilities

Curling Ice Technician

- Prepare, install, and maintain curling ice (scraping, pebbling, flooding, line installation)
- Monitor and assist with ice plant and refrigeration systems
- Maintain ice quality and equipment

Event Setup & Facility Operations

- Perform setup and teardown for events (tables, chairs, staging, etc.)
- Ensure facility readiness for rentals, weddings, and community events
- Provide operational support during events

Facility Maintenance

- Perform general maintenance and minor repairs
- Monitor building systems (HVAC, boiler, plumbing)
- Maintain equipment and facility assets

Leisure Services Support

- Assist with arena operations and ice maintenance
- Support parks, cemetery, and outdoor operations
- Perform snow removal and groundskeeping
- Work at other Leisure Services facilities as required

Working Conditions & Expectations

- Shift work including **days, evenings, and weekends.**
- Work schedules may vary and are subject to change on short notice based on facility operations and programming requirements.
- Ability to work independently and assume responsibility for facility operations
- Ability to manage multiple tasks in a fast-paced environment
- Work in cold indoor and outdoor environments
- Must demonstrate professionalism, teamwork, and positive communication
- Flexibility to support other facilities and operational needs

Physical Requirements

- Physically demanding position
- Frequent lifting of up to 50 lbs
- Ability to perform repetitive tasks and manual labour for extended periods

Qualifications

- Valid Class 5 Driver's License
- Experience in arenas, curling ice, or facility maintenance is an asset
- Ability to perform basic plumbing repairs (e.g., replacing toilets and similar fixtures) is a requirement.
- Mechanical aptitude is considered an asset
- Willingness to obtain required certifications, including but not limited to Curling Ice Tech Level 1 & 2 and Arena Operators Certificate. (training provided)
